2 **MINUTES OF LAST MEETING** (8th February 2017)

3 MATTERS ARISING

Survey results – these have now been analysed and have been posted as graphs on the FNP website.

Cycleways – Jo has made enquiries regarding who to approach re improvement of cycleways. She reported that the agencies to approach for funding are:

- Government
- National Lottery
- People's Postcode Lottery
- Co-op Community Fund

It was suggested that the Parish Council may be able to pursue this funding.

Richard produced maps on which he had marked current cycleways and footpaths. The team also marked out a further map showing main pedestrian routes through the village, congestion areas and pinch points where traffic flow is slow.

4 NAVIGUS UPDATE

Navigus have now produced a skeleton draft plan and this was discussed at length. The following tasks were allocated:

Jo has researched Sport England's website, but reported that it is very complex. She would endeavour to obtain information on general costs of sports clubs. Without any definitive idea at the moment of what land will be available for the sports fields, and exact funds available it is difficult to plan anything. She will speak to a member of the community who may be able to help in the short term. Once the team have met with Wilson Bowden Developments they will have a clearer idea of how to move forward.

Simon will approach someone he knows who is connected with Whittington cricket club in an endeavour to obtain more general information.
